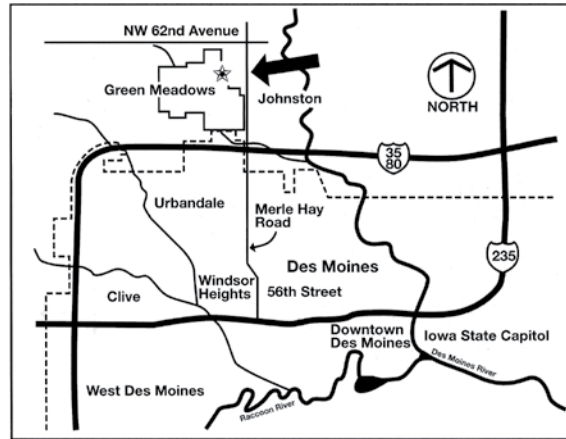

It is estimated that more than 4.5 million Americans, including 68,000 Iowans, have Alzheimer's disease.

- Help residents adapt and adjust to a new environment
- Empower residents to embrace each day of life; and function at the highest emotional, spiritual and physical level possible
- Provide a calm environment and structured daily routine
- Engage residents in social, spiritual, sensory and motor activities they can enjoy and participate in based on their individual needs

- A compassionate and experienced group of physicians and medical professionals trained in geriatric medicine and dementia care
- Access to medical services from Mercy Medical Center – Des Moines, its clinics and other health care services typically provided at Bishop Drumm
- Eleven semi-private rooms that can be customized to include items from a resident's home
- A secured neighborhood with access to an enclosed courtyard, gazebo and garden
- Meals served in a family style setting that can be tailored to an individual's dietary needs
