






Release and Renew Your IP Address

Introduction

Occasionally it is necessary to release and renew your IP address when attempting to connect to a wireless network. This can occur for a number of reasons. You may have been previously attached to this or another wireless network, and your device has merely lost the connection with the wireless network.

Release and Renew the IP Address



Follow the steps below to release and renew your IP address:

Step	Action
1	 Start on the task bar.
2	 Run on the Start menu.
Result	The Windows command line appears:   Note: Your text may differ.
3	Type ipconfig , followed by a space, forward slash(/), release . Example: ipconfig /release
