POLICY:

Mercy Medical Center Residency Programs require residents to document their clinical education by maintaining accurate logs of patient encounters and procedures during their residency programs.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. Based on individual program and specialty board requirements, residents must periodically submit logs to the Program Director for review.
 - American College of Osteopathic Surgeons requires utilization of the Operative Log Collection Site at <u>www.oplog.org</u> with printed copies of the summary report submitted with annual reports. Ongoing data entry is encouraged.
- 2. Program Directors responsible for validating logs and monitoring volumes against specialty college requirements.
- 3. Residents who do not maintain and submit logs as required by their programs will be subject to disciplinary action.
- 4. Program Coordinators responsible to maintain logs in resident files. When Op Log is utilized, a copy of the annual summary log will be saved electronically in the resident's file.
